Chat with Dawn Pfeufer.

Q: How would you define your art? Is it a medium art? A spirit art? Or something totally different?

-I consider my ability to draw those in spirit to be defined as Spirit Art. I don't believe there is a right or wrong title for what it is called as it is more of what you, yourself feel comfortable calling it. My art is multifaceted and depends on what I am called to do in the moment. Sometimes I am inspired to paint a picture, create an aura graph and/or draw a portrait of someone in the spirit world. If I am pulled to create an aura graph, I will work mostly psychic and draw the images and colors that come to me for the person being read. I take note of how I feel for each symbol, number, color, and image I draw. Once complete, I then relay the information to the sitter.

Dawn Pfeufer: We hold so much information in our forever changing auras.

It varies depending on the circumstances of the individual's life and how they are feeling on an emotional, physical, mental, and spiritual level. Essentially, an aura graph is a snapshot in time of an individual's auric field and highlights what is going on in their life at the present moment. When I do a spirit portrait, I set my intention and ask for a loved one in spirit to blend with me.

I trust and allow my spirit guide to draw the portrait of the loved one in spirit who is excited to be connecting with the sitter. Each family member or friend in spirit connects to me differently. For some, they connect clairvoyantly where I will see the loved one in spirit through my mind's eye, other times they connect with me through clairsentience where I can sense and feel them around me. The sketch sometimes will look very much like them other times it will be the essence of who they are.

Depending on the loved one in spirit, they will even correct me as I am drawing. For example, my nose is much smaller then what you have drawn or make me look pretty. It is truly a miracle and a magical moment to witness the connection between the spirit world and their loved ones in the physical. I feel honored and blessed each time I get to participate in reconnecting loved ones. I consider both drawing one's own spirit as an aura graph and drawing a portrait of a loved one who has crossed over both examples of spirit art. I believe art in general is an inspiration of sorts from your spirit within or from those in spirit.

Q: How would you know if the person you are drawing his or her portrait is a deceased person?

 -Loved ones in spirit are intelligent beings and they still have their personality and memories from when they were in the physical.

I am able to feel when I am connecting to loved ones in spirit. Mediumistic and psychic readings feel very different from one another. When I'm connecting to loved ones in spirit, I feel as if their energy is lighter and I am often drained, yet energized afterwards.

When I do mediumistic readings late at night, although I physically feel tired, I would have a hard time falling to sleep due to the energetic vibration of the experience. For me, when doing a psychic reading, it is a heavier feeling. The information comes faster and I can maintain the energetic connection longer than a mediumistic reading. Psychically I receive information as images and feelings, yet there is no two-way communication as you tend to have in mediumistic readings.

Whether I am doing mediumistic or psychic readings, spirit will let you see, hear, feel, taste, and smell or know information.

I communicate with spirit in a similar fashion as I do with my friends and family. As soon as I think of a question, spirit will answer in one form or another.

Although at times, I may not understand the information they are providing me, the sitter or person here in the physical will definitely make the connection.

Spirit may also mention individual names or discuss what is happening in the sitter's life to show they are very much around and remain an active part of their life.

Dawn Pfeufer: Our loved ones in spirit know what needs to be said to help provide healing for all involved.

It is not always about the message that spirit has come forth to give, sometimes it is just about them connecting to let us know that they are doing better than they may have been in the physical. Spirit often connects with love and wants us to know that they are supporting us all from beyond.

Q: After the drawing of the portrait of a person, does the spirit of that person communicate with you afterward?

-This is an interesting question because for me the answer is spirit will often communicate with me before, during, and after a reading. There have been moments when a loved one in spirit is so excited to speak with their loved one that they may show up early prior to the reading.

I will ask them to be patient and wait until the reading so I don't get in my own way of having to remember or question what information has already come through. It is easy to misinterpret what comes through and it is natural to automatically try and make a story of the images instead of trusting and allowing spirit to come through and provide you with the information you are meant to receive. On occasion, I have drawn spirit before a sitting and wrote what information came through.

You can also reconnect with spirit after the reading and get more information or thank them for coming through. Depending on the reading, I may get more information afterwards. It is always a new experience as each individual in spirit is unique and so is the information they are coming through to share. Just like no two individuals are the same, the same can be said for each reading.






